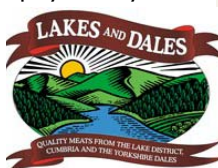
Buy your meat local!

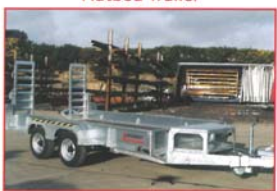

Trade over recent weeks has been very pleasing for all prime sheep with well fleshed continental hoggs well over the 200ppkg mark and export hoggs in the 40—44kg bracket good to place.

The first consignment of new season lambs showed a top price of £117 (272ppkg) with further trade into April seeing overall averages of approx £98 per head or 240ppkg.

Cast ewes too have seen a firm trade with strong continentals selling to a top of around £140 on a weekly basis and nice runs of mule and masham ewes in the late £80s.

Cattle again have been a tremendous trade for both bulls and heifers with simply not enough supply to meet the increasing demand of buyers looking for them.
