TAGGING RULES - CULL EWES

Ewes and rams with full EID tags, excluding electronic slaughter tags, will be sold for either slaughter or further feeding. Those with old style manual tags, can still be batch recorded but it will be announced at the time of sale that they are “sold for slaughter only”
